Words from Fr Brendan Clover

Dear friends,

By the time you read this I imagine that the regional Walsingham Festival will have been and gone. As I sit writing this, before it has happened, I have no idea how many people will attend but I do have an idea about the work many have put into it, most chiefly Martin and the Choir, and Martin and the servers. I extend my deep and sincere thanks to them for this. One of the priorities the PCC articulated was that St John's sought to become a regional centre of Catholic life in the Church of England, and this was the genesis of the Festival. Walsingham has a place of affection in many of our hearts. I have been attending for fifty years! And in October our parish pilgrimage takes place to the shrine departing on Thursday 17th October. All Saints Weston-Super-Mare has its pilgrimage that week departing on Monday 14th October, overlapping for but a few hours on the Thursday. This means that I am out of the parish that week leading the pilgrimages, and so the Monday and Wednesday evening Masses will be suspended.

There are more Festivals afoot...

All Saints Weston-Super-Mare has its Patronal Festival beginning on Friday 1st November with a Solemn Mass at 7pm followed by cheese and wine. On Saturday 2nd November there is a Solemn Requiem Mass at 10.30am, both of these services being sung by Harmonia Sacra and Constanzi, two semi-professional choirs under the baton of Peter Leech.

Wells Cathedral Parish Pass


You may have seen in the news, that Wells Cathedral has announced changes to its admission guidelines with free passes for parishioners in the Diocese of Bath and Wells and local people, and a new entry charge for tourists.

Entry remains free to enter for worship, prayer, and to light a candle and free passes are available for parishioners in the diocese. Information about the Parish Pass and how to apply for it is available from the Wells passes section of the Wells Cathedral website. You will note that the application form for a Parish Pass does require a signature from a churchwarden or incumbent.

The **Evangelist** Gin


Our fund-raising gin is now ready to buy!
